The chart below has been used to explore ideas about Frances Goodrich and Albert Hackett's *The Diary of Anne Frank*, which begins in the PE on page 448.

Title: *The Diary of Anne Frank*, a drama by Frances Goodrich and Albert Hackett

Characters: Mr. and Mrs. Frank, their daughters Margot and Anne, the Van Daan family, Miep Gies, Mr. Kraler, Mr. Dussel

Conflict: The Frank and Van Daan families resist Nazi persecution by going into hiding.

Setting: An apartment hidden behind an office building in Amsterdam, Holland during the 1940s.

Event 1: In 1942, the Frank and Van Daan families go into hiding.

Event 2: An eighth person, Mr. Dussel, joins the "household," and life becomes more difficult.

Event 3: At Hannukah, a thief breaks into the building; everyone fears that the thief will report their hiding place to the police.

Event 4: Anne and Peter Van Daan discuss their situation and come to an understanding.

Climax:	Resolution:
The Nazis discover the "Secret Annex" and arrest everyone who is hiding there.	After the war, Mr. Frank returns to visit the hiding place. He relates that none of his family, the Van Daans, nor Mr. Dussel, survived the concentration camps.
